

On the basis of Article 64a paragraph 5 of the Broadcasting Law ("Official Gazette of RS", nos. 42/02, 97/04, 76/05, 79/05 - oth. law, 62/06 and 85/06), the Council of the Republic Broadcasting Agency (RBA) adopted the

**REGULATION**  
**on the Contents and Form of the ID of the Person Authorised for Enforced Execution of the RBA Council Decisions**

**Article 1**

This regulation prescribes the content and form of the ID of the person authorised for enforced execution of decisions of the RBA Council (hereinafter: the Council).

The ID form referred to in paragraph 1 of this Article is attached to this regulation and presents its integral part.

**Article 2**

The ID of the person authorised for enforced execution of the Council decisions shall contain the following:

A. in the front:

- logo of the Republic Broadcasting Agency,
- name and surname of the person authorised for enforced execution,
- personal registry number of the person authorised for enforced execution,
- photo of the person authorised for enforced execution,
- official number of the ID,

B. in the back:

- printed text as follows: "The holder of this ID has authorisations in accordance with the provision from Article 64a, paragraph 4 of the Broadcasting Law, specifically to seal, in the procedure of enforced execution of the RBA Council decisions, the premises housing the telecommunication equipment of the broadcaster, or legal or natural person broadcasting programme without a license, including a radio station."

- date of ID issue,
- RBA seal,
- signature of the President or Vice President of the Council.

**Article 3**

The form of the ID of the person authorised for enforced execution of the Council decisions shall be printed on offset paper with 85 x 54 mm format, double-sided colour print, laminated.

**Article 4**

The ID shall be taken away from a person authorised for execution of the Council decisions in the event of his employment termination or adoption of the Council decision on the withdrawal of authorisations for which it was issued.

## **Article 5**

If the ID holder loses the ID or is left without it in any other way, he shall, not later than within 24 hours, inform the President or Vice President of the Council accordingly, with a written statement on the time, place and circumstances under which the ID was lost or went missing in a different manner.

In the event referred to in paragraph 1 of this Article the person authorised for enforced execution shall be issued a new ID based on the Council decision, while the old one shall be declared invalid.

## **Article 6**

The ID may also be replaced if worn out, damaged or if the personal data of the ID holder change.

## **Article 7**

The ID which was withdrawn or replaced shall be destroyed by a three-member Committee appointed by the Council President from among the Agency employees.

## **Article 8**

Records shall be kept of the issued, replaced and withdrawn IDs.

The number from the records under which the entry was made shall at the same time be the ID registry number.

## **Article 9**

This regulation shall come into effect on the eighth day from the day of its publication in the "Official Gazette of the Republic of Serbia".
