

Pursuant to Article 39 of the Broadcasting Law ("Official Gazette of the RS" nos. 42/02, 97/04, 76/05 and 79/05 - other law) the Council of the Republic Broadcasting Agency hereby passes the following

## **REGULATION on Broadcasting Licence Form**

### **Article 1**

This Regulation prescribes the form for broadcasting licence which entitles its holder gains to broadcast certain radio and/or television programme intended for an unspecified number of users via terrestrial broadcasting stations, cable distribution systems, satellite radio communications or in another appropriate manner.

The licence form referred to in paragraph 1 herein is attached to this Regulation and presents its integral part.

### **Article 2**

The broadcasting licence form shall be printed on an A4 offset paper.

### **Article 3**

This Regulation shall come into effect as of the eighth day from the day of its publication in the "Official Gazette of the Republic of Serbia".

Pursuant to Article 46 of the Broadcasting Law, the broadcasting licence as well as the radio station licence are non-transferable and inalienable.
